

Course Description

- This course aims to familiarize graduate students with **fundamental skills** concerning academic English writing. This course includes two hours of lecture plus one hour of grammar discussion (and weekly quiz). Topics to be covered include common rhetorical patterns, paragraph/essay development, grammar functionality, and essential vocabulary in academic English.

 - ▣ Understand common rhetoric modes in academic writing.
 - ▣ Apply their knowledge of grammar function to their own writing.
 - ▣ Demonstrate familiarity with vocabulary frequently used in academic writing.
 - ▣ Edit and proofread their own and their peers' writing.
