Cause-Effect: Tips


- > Carefully **distinguish** the causes of an event from its effects
- ➤ Be wary of the post **hoc fallacy**; ensure that the causal relationship can be evidentially supported
- ➤ Use **hedged expressions** where appropriate
 - E.g., may, might, should, could, seem, appear, sometimes, probably
 Smoking cannabis causes schizophrenia.
 Smoking cannabis may cause schizophrenia.
- > Use appropriate **transition signals**
