- Compare and contrast methods for promoting a new business, product, or service.




Different Organizations

 - **Transition paragraph:** to separate one major section from another major section.

TSS for Comparison & Contrast

- Even though both Momoko and Regine share some similarities, they also have their own uniqueness.
- Despite the similarities, Momoko and Regine differ in three aspects: life values, interpersonal skills and public images.
- While Momoko and Regine receive very different public feedbacks, they are in fact very similar in personalities and achievements.

- The similarities between Momoko and Regine in their **personalities** and **achievements** have further highlighted their differences in **popularities** and **public images**.
